Dear Ms. Bernstein,

On February 20, 2020, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission granted PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC (PennEast) an extension of time to complete construction and make the PennEast Pipeline Project available for service by January 19, 2022.¹ Commission staff has become aware of conflicting statements in press reports and court filings regarding whether PennEast plans to continue developing the project. Accordingly, PennEast should file, within seven days of the date of this letter, a status report, including a statement as to whether PennEast still plans to construct the project.
