No Gibbstown LNG Export Terminal!

The Gibbstown Logistics Center is currently being built on the former DuPont Repauno property. The companies behind the project, Delaware River Partners & New Fortress Energy, want to construct a second dock to export highly-volatile Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) and Natural Gas Liquids (NGL). This would triple the number of berths for ships and turn the site into a massive gas export terminal, with over 1,400 truck trips per day and rail cars delivering flammable and hazardous LNG and NGL to Gibbstown for export down the Delaware River – endangering communities throughout South Jersey, along the river, and along the transit routes. The NGL would be stored in tanks or the site’s underground cavern to be shipped overseas, at no benefit to NJ residents.
