

Algonquin Pipeline Expansion Project – Spectra Energy

Spectra Energy is proposing a project which will expand the Algonquin pipeline significantly. It will connect the Millennium and Tennessee pipelines in Ramapo and Mahwah to bring Marcellus Shale gas through Rockland, Westchester and Putnam Counties in New York State and then into Connecticut, Massachusetts and Rhode Island where the gas will be delivered. The project includes modification of five compressor stations, two in Rockland and Putnam Counties and 25 existing metering stations, plus an addition of two metering stations.
