



Millennium Pipeline Company's Hancock Compressor Project

The Very Basics:

- 15,000 horsepower compressor, fueled by natural gas, to increase capacity of the Millennium pipeline.
- Proposed for construction on a 10.8 acre parcel located at 1579 Hungry Hill Road, Hancock, Delaware County, NY. Parcel is already owned by Millennium.
- The chosen site is forest land; in closer to noise sensitive areas in most instances than other options; affects lands with 8 to 20% slopes; requires clearing 4.1 acres of trees; impact 0.4 acres of wetlands; requires crossing 2 natural waterways; has 3.1 acres of highly erodible soils that will be worked on; and includes 3.1 acres of shallow bedrock that may require blasting or other special construction techniques.
- Air emissions will include nitrogen oxide (NO_x), carbon monoxide (CO) and particulate matter (PM).
- Two buildings will be constructed on site, along with an access road and parking. The two buildings: (1) the compressor will be housed in a building that is 90'X60'; (2) second "control building" will be constructed that is approximately 36'X100'.
- Projected to go in service November 2013
- Considered a "minor emissions source" under the air law.
- Currently in the pre-application stage before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). Project will be reviewed by FERC pursuant to the interstate natural gas facility permitting process.
